Updates

Budget Overview

Roughly \$45,000

Bulk of income comes from fundraising, \$36,000 Rest from membership, events, and income caryover

Expenses fall in 5 main categories

Teacher/student support: \$11,500

Events: \$ 9,500

Enrichment: \$ 8,000

Fundraising: \$ 8,000

Operations: \$ 6,000

Building Update

- Woodlin ES is going to be rebuilt to address condition and capacity
- Schematic design work occurred over summer 2020
 - Three public meetings were held to get Woodlin and community input
- Construction design to occur fall 2020 through spring 2021
- Current budget has construction starting in Jan 2023 and the new school opening in September 2024 (18 months for construction)
 - During this time students would be in a holding school (Grosvenor ES)


Upcoming Activities


After-school Clubs
