# Update on Woodlin Re-build

- Full funding of CIP is currently \$150M short
- Montgomery County is hoping to secure monies to fund more projects in CIP, but may have to delay some projects
- A Progressive recordation tax was proposed to replace funds that were cut from school impact taxes during the Growth Policy update. We advocate that those funds be added back by scheduling the recordation tax vote or another action that would raise revenue.
