New Building & Temporary Relocating

Facility planning for additions at Woodlin has been considered since 2011, but after a change in MCPS' assessment process, the plan was expanded to a Major Capital Project (a new building), with a scheduled completion date of September 2023. Thanks to all who wrote in support of the project, the Planning Board approved Woodlin's rebuild project with recommendations on Thursday 9/30!
