- Children are childish. Are the expectations developmentally appropriate and fair?
- When misbehaving: ask don't tell. Check in with them
- Redirect what TO do, not what not to do. They already know they're doing what they shouldn't be.
- Listen actively
  - Wait for the right time
  - Show interest
  - Validate
  - Reflect, repeat
- Catch them being good
- Respect. Show it.
- Deposit positivity. Improve ratio of positive to negative
- Kids are fun. You can be too.
- Pandemic life. Re-adjusting, re-directing is tough.

Q. How do ES kids do with virtual therapy. Do you have experience?

: done groups with ES and it worked well, but have not done one-on-one. Thinks virtual can be effective, but would recommend in-person for little kids
