#### **Building Update**

- 1. We'll be in the new building in January
- 2. Construction currently working 2 shifts to get it done
- 3. Waiting for approval to send timelines to parents; pushing new directors for direction because staff and parents need to plan
- 4. We'll move back to Tier one schedule of 9am start and 3:25pm dismissal
- 5. Unsure who can use building other than KAH outside of school hours
- 6. Be patient as they work through the new building kinks
- 7. Mr. Jackson is trying to lobby for an additional day to set up
  - a. A PTA member suggested parents would be able to help, with general agreement. Mr. Jackson isn't sure what will be allowed.

- 8. Ordered building services
- 9. Technology
  - a. Each classroom/workspace will have a smart board. Each teacher gets a laptop.
  - b. Everything in building is new (including trash cans, etc)
  - c. Not much will move from W@G to new Woodlin
  - d. New kitchenettes and toys
  - e. Board expects everything to be top notch
- 10. Brookeville issues still being worked through
- 11. Woodlin will request a crossing guard on Brookeville
- 12. Kids After Hours Director Andrew addressing their plans
  - a. 40-person waitlist right now, waiting to see what the space allows
  - b. 7-opening; close-6:30
  - c. Committed to serving all families needing care
- 13. Woodlin CDC will remain at its current location until maybe April 2024
- 14. Mr. Jackson showed design slides (modular furniture, some spatial renderings and color schemes)
- 15. Spaces are generally bigger, lots more natural light
- 16. School will be colorful
- 17. There will be lockers but don't expect much use
- 18.We may get a pre-K program in the future
- 19.Primary (K+1) and 2 second grade classes on first floor; Intermediary classes (3-5) will be on second floor plus the other 2 second grade classes; LFI downstairs?

- 20. School enrollment continues to increase
  - a. We will be full when building opens
  - b. 6 shell classrooms in new building that they may need to outfit now to accommodate numbers
  - c. future school status may change class sizes if we become a focus school (see <u>here</u> for info on Title 1 versus focus school status) depending on our FARMS numbers
- 21. Playground will be ready, school will be fenced along Luzerne Ave.
- 22.We doubt we'll be used for summer programs this year, but probably in the future
- 23. Full school assemblies can happen in gymnasium
- 24. 5th grade graduation should happen at Woodlin
- 25. Unlikely to be able to schedule or host an open house to allow kids to familiarize themselves with the school prior to the move in January
- 26.Transportation is working on the new bus routes. We should have information by early December. We will lose some bus routes with the return of walkers.
- 27. Woodlin CDC is working on getting their bus route worked out.
- 28.Emphasis is on learning; the goal of new building and amenities are all to facilitate learning and doing your best
