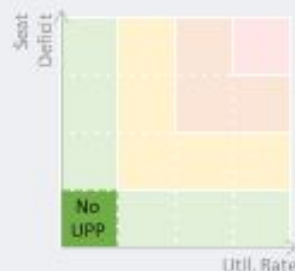

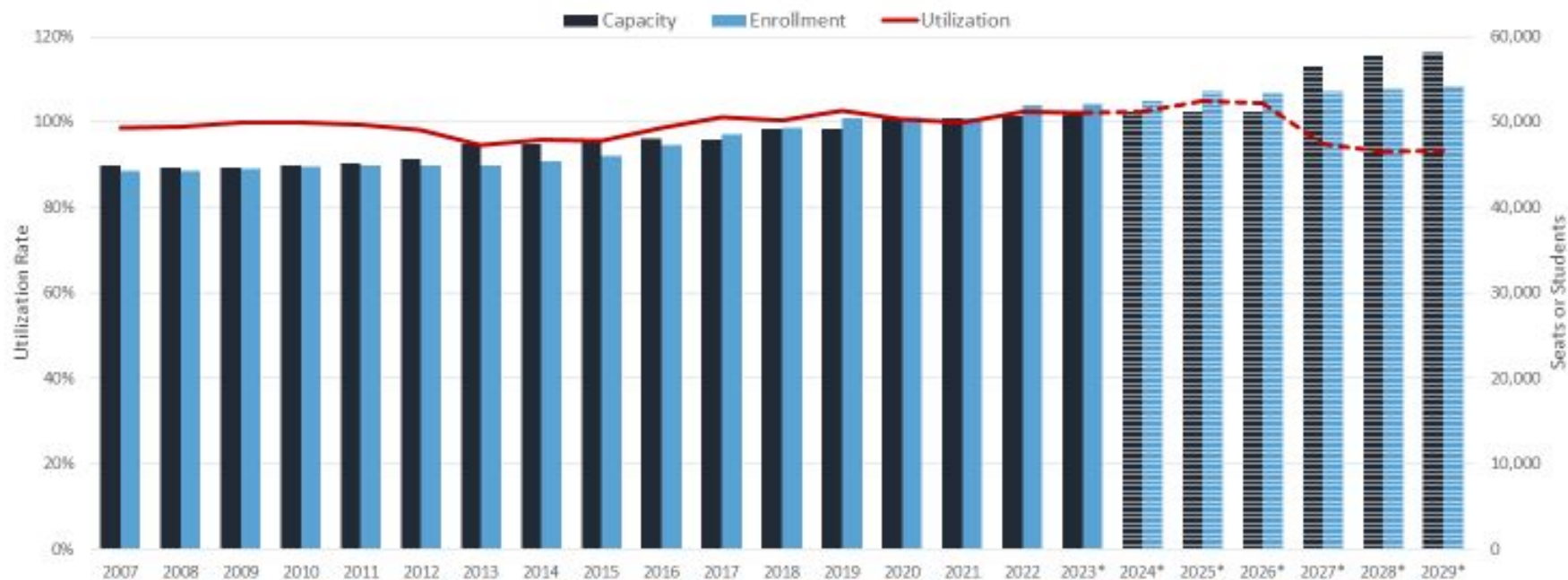

High Schools – Countywide Enrollment/Utilization Trend



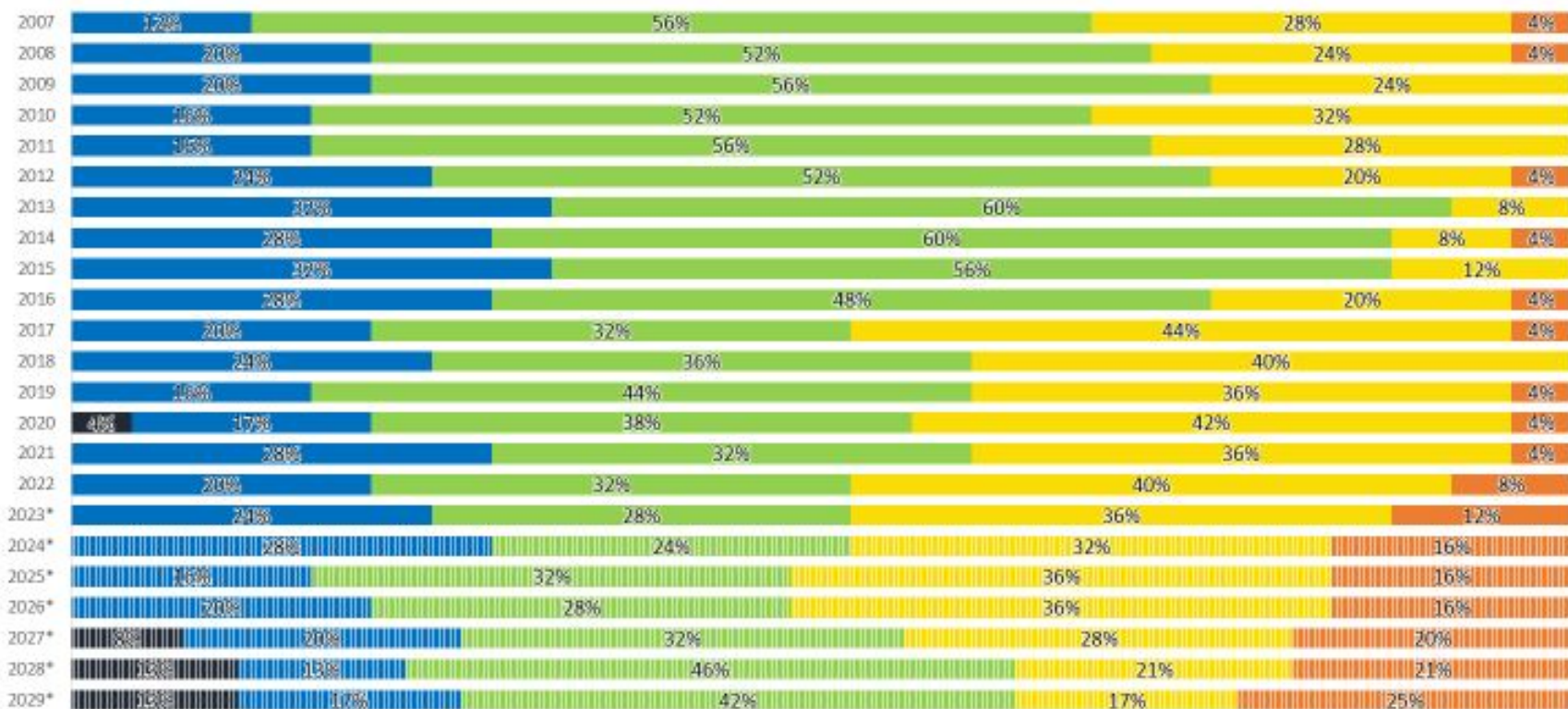

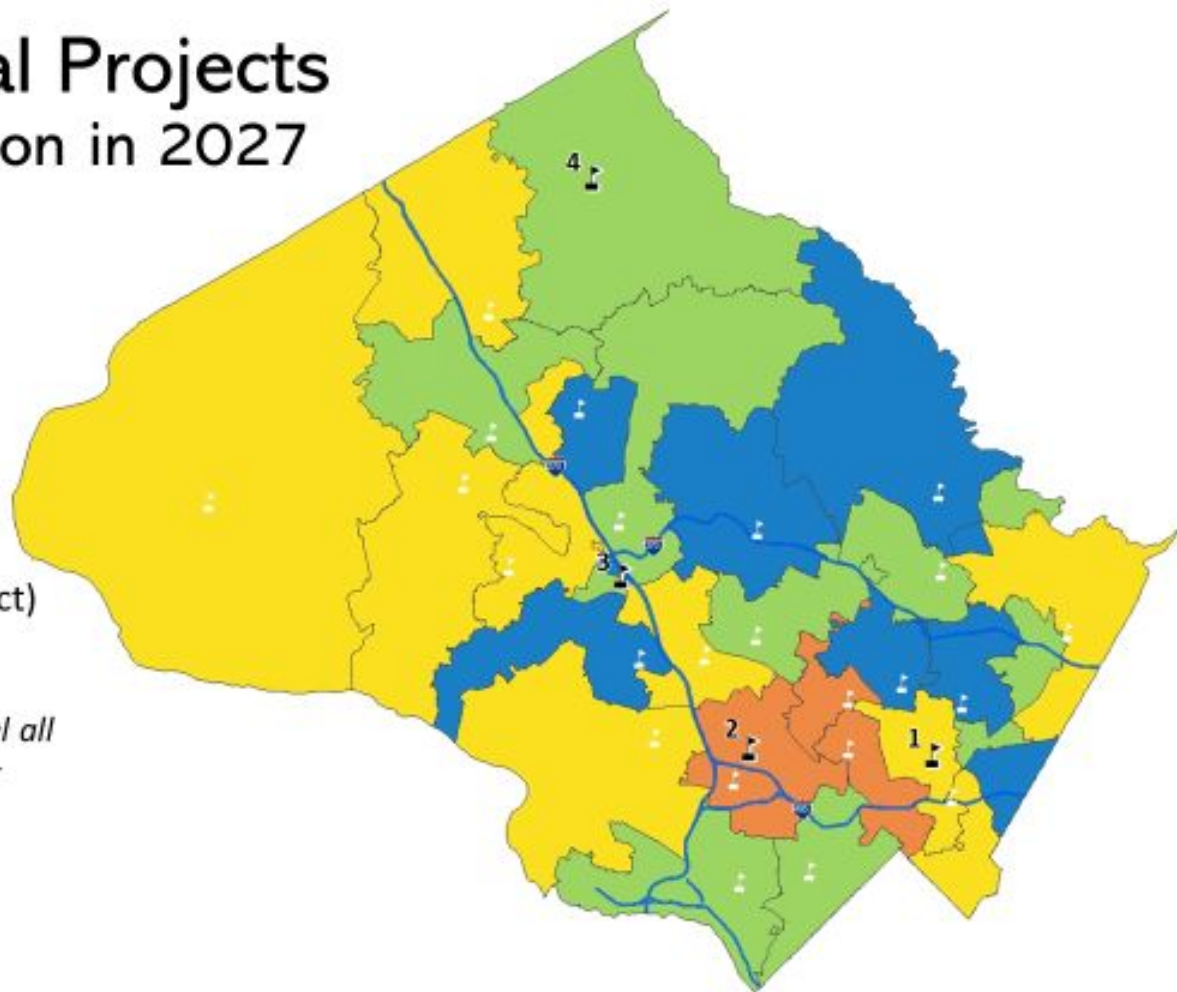
