"CHOICE" SCHOOLS (MSMC)

3 schools: (Middle School Magnet Consortium)

Parkland, Argyle & Loiederman

- A computer randomly selects you for these programs based on your choices.
- If you get selected and you choose to go, you would go to one of these schools INSTEAD of going to your local middle school.
- Transportation is **not** provided to the PAL schools

Argyle Magnet School for Digital Design and Development is designed for students who are interested in:

- Developing computer programming skills Understanding how IMAX movies are made
- Learning to design Web pages
 Using the latest digital software to create video games





A. Mario Loiederman Magnet School for the Creative and Performing Arts is designed for students who are interested in:

- Creating their own sculptures and drawings
- Creating stage sets for plays or school performances
- Performing on stage or working behind the scenes
- Discovering the arts through singing, dancing, and music

Parkland Magnet School for Aerospace Technology is designed for students who are interested in:

- Exploring the world through math and science
- Designing, building, and programming robots
- Meeting scientists and engineers
- Using tools to learn -- like Lego kits and robo labs



MIDDLE SCHOOL MAGNET (CRITERIA BASED) SCHOOLS

- <u>Eastern Middle School</u>- Humanities and Communication Program
- <u>Takoma Park Middle School</u>- Math, Science, Computer Science Program

The Process for Admission:

A universal review of all Grade 5 students' academic profile using multiple measures that include 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school year MAP-R and MAP-M scores, reading level, report card grades, and student services.

- Students who demonstrate a need for enriched programming will be placed into a lottery pool.
- Students in this pool will be guaranteed enrichment in either a middle school regional program or local school enriched programming/courses.
- Transportation is provided to both Eastern MIddle School and Takoma Park MIddle School.

MATH PATHWAYS

The pathways for math students are as follows:

- Students in Math 5 go to either Math 6 or Accelerated Math 6+.
- Students in compacted Math go to Math 7+ or Math 7.
- Students more than 2 years below grade level additional Math Intervention (Math 180)

If students were in the compacted 5/6 Math course this year but aren't quite ready for AMP Math 7+, they are eligible to take Math 7 which is still advanced math and leads to Algebra I in 8th grade, but contains only 7th grade standards, instead of both 7th and 8th grade standards.


